#### 01 Mattias Andersson

In the following years, he served as the Deputy Chief of Mission and Head of the political section at the EU Delegation to Lebanon in Beirut and as the Consul General of the Republic of Poland in New York.

Maciej sits on an advisory board of the Integral Economic Development master programs at the Catholic University of America in Washington D.C. and for almost 10 years has been associated with the Sobieski Institute in Warsaw as an expert on the EU as well as foreign policy. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy, politics and economics from Washington and Lee University, as well as a Master of Arts degree in political science from the Johns Hopkins University. He also holds an International Baccalaureate Diploma from the United World College of the Atlantic in the United Kingdom.

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
