Corporate governance is an important component of the Capital Market Masterplan (CMP) in charting the path ahead for the Malaysian capital market and further emphasized by the recent CMP3, launched in September 2021. In addition to that, the SC's Corporate Governance Strategic Priorities (2021-2023) was launched as a response to the rise of stakeholder economy that calls for businesses to create value for a wider spectrum of stakeholders, including the society, to have conscious consideration for the environment impact.

This programme will look into the 2021 update of the MCCG updates, observations from the Corporate Governance Monitor 2021 report as well as the SC's CG Strategic Priorities 2021 – 2023 and the interlink between corporate governance and sustainable practices in delivering long term value and sustainable growth.

enhancement technology adoption and branding. She also spearheaded strategic, operational, and financial plan to ensure effectiveness and efficiency. In addition, she was also involved in auditing and accounting regulatory function including financial statement review, audit quality and professional ethics. She has engaged with stakeholders of different sectors locally and globally including ministries, government agencies, companies, media, universities, business leaders and individuals. She also delivered keynote addresses and speeches locally and globally. Her recent work revolves around Integrated Reporting, ESG and the future of Corporate Reporting.

Dr Nurmazilah is a Certified Public Accountant, a Certified Internal Auditor and holds the Certified Risk Management and Assurance qualification. She holds a PhD in accounting from the University of Birmingham, United Kingdom. She recently completed a course on climate change and Net Zero from the University of Cambridge.

Dr. Nurmazilah played active roles at International Federation of Accountants, International Integrated Reporting Framework Board and ASEAN Federation of Accountants. She has also served as the MIA Council member, a member of the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board, member of Board of Governors for the Institute of Internal Auditors, Council member of the Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants, and Honorary Treasurer with Persatuan Ekonomi Malaysia. Dr Nurmazilah is a member of MIA, MICPA, and ASEAN CPA.



Tan Sri Andrew Sheng

Tan Sri Andrew Sheng is a former central banker and financial regulator in Asia and a commentator on global finance. He is Pro-Chancellor of Bristol University and Distinguished Fellow, Asia Global Institute, University of Hong Kong, as well as Chairman, George Town Institute of Open and Advanced Studies, Wawasan Open University, Malavsia.

Tan Sri Andrew is the Chief Adviser to the China Banking and Insurance Regulatory Commission, a member of the international advisory council of the China Investment Corporation, the China Development Bank, and China Securities Regulatory Commission.

Tan Sri Andrew served as Chairman of the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong from 1998 to 2005, having previously been a central banker with the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and Bank Negara Malaysia. He also worked with the World Bank from 1989 to 1993. From 2003 to 2005, he chaired the Technical Committee of the International Organisation of Securities Commissions (IOSCO). He was a Board Member of Khazanah Nasional Berhad, the sovereign wealth fund of Malaysia.

He has a First Class Honours in Economics from Bristol University, and Honorary Doctorates from University of Bristol and University of Malaya. He is an Adjunct Professor at the Graduate School of Economics and Management, Tsinghua University, Beijing and Faculty of Economics, University of Malaya.

He is author of "From Asian to Global Financial Crisis: An Asian Regulator's View of Unfettered Finance in the 1990s and 2000s" (2009), and co-editor (with Ng Chow Soon) of the book, "Bringing Shadow Banking into the Light: Opportunity for Financial Reform in China" (2015). He writes regularly on international finance and monetary economics, financial regulation and global governance for Project Syndicate, AsiaNewsNet and leading economic magazines and newspapers in China and Asia. In April 2013, Andrew was named by Time magazine as one of the 100 most influential people in the world. He also appeared in the Oscarwinning film "Inside Job" in 2011.
